**RULES FOR CLUB USE - PRIVATE PARTIES**  
*Amended to March 2014*

- I All private functions using Niagara Sailing Club facilities must be sponsored by a NSC member, who shall ensure that the Club rules are followed and that the private group exercises the proper decorum with respect to Club property, as well as the surrounding private property and rights.

Generally, the club is available for these activities from October through May but may be scheduled during the boating season subject to NSC's schedule.

**II Outside Organizations**

**NO POOL OR DOCK USE!**

1. Any outside organization using the NSC clubhouse shall be subjected to a \$150.00 contribution.
2. An NSC member is **REQUIRED** to act as bartender for any function serving alcoholic beverages unless an outside bartender is hired by host member.
3. All drinks **MUST** be purchased from the NSC bar. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE CLUB PREMISES FOR THESE OCCASIONS.**
4. The clubhouse shall be left in good condition
5. If NSC must assume the obligation of cleaning-up, a \$50.00 clean-up fee will be assessed to the organization.

**III Outside organizations with NSC Affiliation**

1. The club requires a \$100.00 contribution when a boating group with NSC affiliations or interests requests Clubhouse use.
2. The event/meeting must be sponsored by a NSC fleet or group, who will take the responsibility of guaranteeing adherence to NSC rules.

3. The organization must provide for a clean-up crew.
4. **All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from the bar using the "private price list".**

#### **IV Club Member**

1. The contribution may be waived under specified circumstances (refer to Waiver of Contribution) but generally the contribution remains at \$100.00.  
Special concessions may be made in other areas.
2. The club member is responsible for cleaning before and after the event and providing bartender(s) and other items as may be necessary.

#### **V Waiver of Contribution**

1. The contribution may be waived by the Board of Directors provided special circumstances are met. Greater than 50% of those persons attending the event should be NSC family members.
2. If a NSC member has a small gathering, which does not preclude the use of the club by other NSC members not **invited to the event, no contribution is required. The same general rules apply as previously specified.**
